



## Cleaning a Floorify floor in a commercial application

### FIRST CLEANING AFTER INSTALLATION

#### STEP 1:

Remove loose dirt and dust using a soft brush and/or a soft-headed vacuum cleaner.

#### STEP 2:

##### *Manual cleaning*

- Dilute the intensive cleaner **Conny Turbo**, in a ratio of 1:50, with warm water.
- Apply the solution evenly to the floor.  
Do not allow the solution to dry. Clean the floor in floorboards.
- Use a scrubbing brush with soft bristles to scrub the floor.  
Avoid harder hairs that can scratch the floor.
- Absorb loosened dirt with a clean, damp mop.  
Use a separate bucket, filled with clean water, to rinse your mop between. This keeps the mop water in the other bucket clean.
- If necessary, repeat the previous steps until you see clean water in the bucket.
- Always clean the floor thoroughly with clean, pure water and a clean mop without leaving any residue.
- Leave the floor dry.

##### *Mechanical cleaning*

- Dilute the intensive cleaner **Conny Turbo**, in a ratio of 1:50, with warm water.
- Place the solution in the reservoir of the cleaning machine.  
When choosing the type of cleaning machine, one should opt for a scrubbing - suction machine or a rotowash function with immediate water recovery.  
**! Carefully read the regulations before using a cleaning machine!**
- Always clean the floor thoroughly with clean, pure water (without detergent) in the reservoir of the cleaning machine or manually.
- Leave the floor dry.

## DAILY/ WEEKLY MAINTENANCE

### STEP 1:

Remove loose dirt and dust using a soft brush and/or a soft-headed vacuum cleaner.

### STEP 2:

#### **Manual cleaning**

- Dilute the mild cleanser **Conny**, in a ratio of 1:200, with warm water.
- The floor should only be cleaned with a clean, damp mop, use a separate bucket filled with clean water to rinse your mop in between. This keeps the mop water in the other bucket clean.
- Let the floor dry in a normal way.

#### **Mechanical cleaning**

- Dilute the mild cleanser **Conny**, in a ratio of 1:200, with warm water.
- Place the solution in the reservoir of the cleaning machine.  
When choosing the type of cleaning machine, one should opt for a scrubbing suction machine or a rotowash function with immediate water recovery.  
**! Carefully read the regulations before using a cleaning machine!**
- Let the floor dry naturally.

## CLEAN THOROUGHLY OR PERIODICALLY (2-3 ANNUALLY)

### STEP 1:

Remove loose dirt and dust using a soft brush and/or a soft-headed vacuum cleaner.

### STEP 2:

#### **Manual cleaning**

- Dilute the intensive cleaner **Conny Turbo**, in a ratio of 1:50, with warm water.
- Apply the solution evenly to the floor.  
Do not allow the solution to dry. Clean the floor in floorboards.
- Use a scrubbing brush with soft bristles to scrub the floor.  
Avoid harder hairs that can scratch the floor.
- Absorb loosened dirt with a clean, damp mop.  
Use a separate bucket, filled with clean water, to rinse your mop in between. This keeps the mop water in the other bucket clean.
- If necessary, repeat the previous steps until you see clean water in the bucket.
- Always clean the floor thoroughly with clean, pure water and a clean mop without leaving any residue.
- Leave the floor dry.

### ***Mechanical cleaning***

### ***Cleaning with a steam cleaner***

The use of a steam cleaner with a wide nozzle is possible, if the following things are considered:

- Avoid direct contact of the steam on the floor by using a microfiber cloth/pad on the steam opening. This ensures that the steam and heat are evenly distributed.
- Keep the contact of the steam on the floor as short as possible and set the device to the lowest setting.
- Absorb any deposited dirt with a clean cloth.
- Do not use any cleaning products in a steam cleaner, as these can affect the steam cleaner.
- You will achieve better results by cleaning the boards lengthways.
- Placed adhesive skirting boards can come loose due to the combination of steam and heat on the tape with which the adhesive plinths are attached. In this case it is advised to stay a few cm away from the adhesive skirting boards to prevent this.
- Make sure to dry the floor completely immediately after cleaning with a dry cloth or a mop.

## **RESTORATIVE CLEANING**

### **STEP 1:**

Follow the steps described in the section "Thorough or periodic cleaning" except for steam cleaning.

### **STEP 2:**

- Dilute the restorative cleaner **Conny Care**, in a ratio of 1:100, with warm water.
- Only clean the floor with a clean, damp mop.  
Use a separate bucket, filled with clean water, to rinse your mop in between. This keeps the mop water in the other bucket clean.
- Let the floor dry naturally.  
Ensure you leave to dry for approx. 45 minutes!

## GENERAL POINTS OF ATTENTION

- Avoid excessive use of cleaning solution on the floor. With intensive cleaning, moisture can get under the floor, which can affect the screed in the longer term. Ensure dirty water is fully cleaned off with clean water.
- When using cleaning products locally, colour/gloss disturbances may occur.
- This is because the floor in that place becomes much cleaner than the rest of the floor.
- Do not bring sensitive surfaces (e.g., wood, metal, furniture, ...) into contact with intensive cleaning solutions.
- When used in higher concentrations, wear household gloves.
- With machine cleaning and a heavier soiled floor the use of the intensive cleaner 'Conny Turbo' is not always necessary. Often the dirt will also be removed with the mild cleaner 'Conny'. Limit the use of intensive cleaning products as much as possible.

### Regarding the use of the mild cleaner Conny:

- The use of another cleaning product outside the Conny cleaner is possible, if it is suitable for PVC floors and is pH neutral (pH 7).
- Never use maintenance products that contain wax and oil. Do not use vinegar, polishing or abrasives, corrosive detergents, or solvents.

### Regarding the use of the intensive cleaner Conny Turbo:

- When using the intensive cleaner Conny Turbo, cleaning the floor afterwards with clean, pure water is necessary! Cleaning residues that remain will capture dirt and make the floor more sensitive to dirt adhesion. Post-cleaning also ensures the neutralization of the floor.
- In case of persistent contamination, the concentration of Conny Turbo can be increased to undiluted use. In case of undiluted use, the floor should always be cleaned with the addition of warm water, in combination with a soft scrubbing broom.  
Depending on the contamination, the pure product can be left on the floor for about 10 minutes (do not let it dry!).
- When using the Conny Turbo, switch off any underfloor heating that may be present. This ensures that the (mixed) product does not dry immediately.

### Regarding the use of the restorative cleaner Conny Care:

- Conny Care contains a polish component that will form an extra protective layer on the floor every time after cleaning. This will extend the life of the floor. Superficial scratches or streaks and natural traces of aging will also become less visible.
- The floor may not be walked on for approx. 45 minutes (= drying process). Otherwise foot prints may remain on the floor.
- If this happens accidentally, you can repair the floor with the intensive cleaner Conny Turbo.
- If, after maintenance with the Conny Care, the floor is cleaned again with the Conny Turbo, the applied protective layers will be removed, and the floor will be brought back to its neutral base.
- It is advised to use a full bottle of Conny Care (+- 10 cleanings). This is to achieve a full result in terms of scratches and stains.
- Clean the floor in one mop. There is a small chance of visible difference, due to the overlap, when cleaning different rooms separately.

- After using the Conny Care maintenance product, the daily/weekly maintenance can continue with the mild cleaner Conny.
- Carefully follow the instructions for use described on the bottle.
- In commercial application, this may not be feasible due to the drying process.
- Mechanically, this cleaning agent cannot be applied.
